

## NWIACC Advisory Board meeting

April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018 1 pm O'Brien County Courthouse Assembly Room

The meeting was called to order at 1 pm with 6 members present in person and no one on the phone.

There was a brief update by Kim Wilson on the current status for Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) and Mobile Crisis as contracted through Seasons Center as well as the Mobile Crisis Services.

Kim Wilson also reported on Individualized Placement and Supports (IPS) options through Hope Haven as well as the Peer Support Network.

Kim Wilson gave an update about the HF 2456 regarding the additional core services being added to core services. She also provide information about the "Familiar Faces" Pilot Project in Dickinson County, which was one of the recommendations of this region's SF 504 Community Services Plan along with the Board's discussion about local and state-wide SF 504 data collection.

Kim Wilson gave an update on the regional Stepping Up Initiative and the new Jail Release Care Coordination service contracted through Hope Haven. The Zero Suicide Project in Palo Alto County is hosting an event sponsored by the Region "Caring for the Inner You" on May 9<sup>th</sup> and information was shared about that.. Conversation about trying to have a local A.S.I.S.T trainer was discussed.

Kim Wilson gave an update on the work of the C-3 De-escalation Trainers which is starting this spring.

We received an update on the Motivational Interviewing Training is coming up April 24-25<sup>th</sup> with Mark Dodd.

We also reviewed work of the regional Transitional Living Team, who are working on a central intake model and integrated resource directory for regional partners involved with housing.

We received an update on the RIDES grant with DOT that the region is partnering with for employment and essential needs transportation in Clay County at this time.

There were no concerns expressed about regional operations in enrollment, claims processing, quality improvement or administration.

The next quarterly meeting will be held Monday, July 9, 2018 at 1 pm at the O'Brien County Courthouse.
