

NWIACC Advisory Board meeting

October 15th, 2018 1 pm O'Brien County Courthouse Assembly Room

The meeting was called to order at 1 pm with 4 members present and one guest.

We discussed questions brought forward with the discussions about regional expansion. Information was shared about the recent requests from various counties from the current regions of County Social Services and Sioux Rivers and the process to determine eligibility to join.

Kim Wilson gave an update about the HF 2456 regarding the additional core services and the work being done to address local access center networks of services. We talked about Workforce Shortage issues and its effect on service delivery. A regional team meeting will be scheduled shortly.

We talked about the results of the SF 504 Community Services Plan and data collection. We talked about the upcoming Stepping Up Initiative Summit next week in Des Moines.

There was discussion about the conference tomorrow regarding implementing Evidence Based practices. (EBPs) Scott Witte gave information about Hope Haven's work with the Individual Placement and Supports (IPS) Supported Employment EBP in our region.

There were updates about the Zero Suicide Projects as well as C3 De-escalation Trainings being held.

There were updates about Crisis Services and attempts to address Transitional Living needs associated with crises.

There were no concerns expressed about regional operations in enrollment, claims processing, quality improvement or administration.

The next quarterly meeting will be held Monday, January 14, 2019 at 1 pm at the O'Brien County Courthouse.
